Today, we have had the first of our two transition sessions across the school. This gives all of our tamariki time with their kaiako and class members for 2024.

We know change can be challenging and this has been the focus of our Inquiry topic this term so that we can provide every learner with strategies to embrace the opportunities of change with a positive mindset.

We spent a lot of time getting the balance right when creating each class. Every child has input into a buddy/friend they want in with them and we ensure that this happens. We don't offer more than 1 as we have to split some year groups across 2 or 3 spaces.

The children are aware that not all of their friends will be with them but they will have plenty of opportunities to work with them during the year.

HVS JUNIOR NETBALL TERM 1 2024

HVS Junior Netball - Summer League Year 1-4 -Register by Monday 12th Feb

The summer season is upon us and we are preparing for junior netball. Motu Kairangi Netball is now accepting registrations for the ANZ futureFERNS Netball Programme for children (boys and girls) in Year 1 to Year 4, in term 1, 2024. The summer season begins on Saturday, 17 February for both year groups and runs for 9 weeks at Evans Bay Intermediate School Kilbirnie (EBIS).

<u>Year 1 & 2 team/s</u> Coaches/Star Helpers for, whānau are needed as Star Helpers to assist with the skills sessions and games. This group have 4 players on court at a time, so 4vs4 (minimum players 5 in a team).

<u>Year 3 & 4 team/s</u> need a coach who will also control the game on Saturdays (there is no umpire as such). This group have 5 players on court, so 5vs5 (minimum players 6 in a team). If not enough for teams we can register you as an individual players.

Cost per player is \$40 per player for Term 1 2024. The registration deadline for "school teams" and "individual players" and is Monday, 12th February 2024. This deadline must be kept as we need to know at HVS how many teams to register in the league.
