Kia Ora Whānau,

Ngā mihi o te tau hou! There is plenty to be excited about, especially our new people joining HVS.

It has been a joy seeing all our new tamariki start their school journey! New whānau - thank you for taking time to say hello. We are pleased to have you join our school community. If I have not met you yet, feel free to come on in for a chat.

We have also welcomed our three new teachers, Nina Hornell, Felix Cullen and Claire Keys, as well as our new Sign Language Assistant Bibi Grainer.

Later today, we will be emailing out all the beginning of year documents - donations, Activity fee, permission slip, and swimming.

The key one we need back by Monday at the latest is the signed permission slip for trips-**2024 Annual Permission Slip, Activity Fee** as we are off to the beach on Monday. We don't need the money, just your signature!

With the implementation of our new Strategic Plan, we have been looking at how we bring this to life.

Goal 2 is about utilising the outdoors and our local community more into our learning programmes so have been looking at ways to do this more for 2024. We have our first trip organised and planned for Monday 5 February to head over to Lyall Bay beach. To do this we require all whanau to sign and return the permission slip this week, so this has come home in your child's bag today. You may need to search for it.

Beach Trip - Helpers Needed!

We are heading to Lyall Beach on Monday 5 February to have some fun and to make the most of our local places.

Our tamariki are encouraged to bring togs, towels, change of clothes and buckets and spades. They will also need a sun hat, sunscreen and extra food as they often get really hungry after a sea swim.

We will have time to swim (optional) and make sand sculptures. As this is a big day out, whanau can choose to meet us at the beach at 2.00pm to pick up their child and take them home so they don't need to walk back to school. If you are planning to do this then you need to have told their classroom teacher before we leave on Monday morning.

We also require helpers. Please email - your child's teacher or Luana on principal@houghton.school.nz if you can walk with us and stay to supervise. We will leave school at 9.30 and return about 2.15pm.

This year we have been able to extend the amount of lessons compared to the previous year.

This year all Year 5 and 6's will participate in a water safety programme for 2 weeks as part of the learn to swim programme.

HVS JUNIOR NETBALL TERM 1 2024

HVS Junior Netball - Summer League Year 1-4 – Register by Monday 12th Feb

The summer season is upon us, and we are preparing for junior netball. Motu Kairangi Netball is now accepting registrations for the ANZ futureFERNS Netball Programme for children (boys and girls) in Year 1 to Year 4, in term 1, 2024. The summer season begins on Saturday, 17 February for both year groups and runs for 9 weeks at Evans Bay Intermediate School Kilbirnie (EBIS).

Year 1 & 2 team/s Coaches/Star Helpers for, whānau are needed as Star Helpers to assist with the skills sessions and games. This group have 4 players on court at a time, so 4vs4 (minimum players 5 in a team).

<u>Year 3 & 4 team/s</u> need a coach who will also control the game on Saturdays (there is no umpire as such). This group have 5 players on court, so 5vs5 (minimum players 6 in a team). If not enough for teams, we can register you as an individual players.

Cost per player is \$40 per player for Term 1 2024. *The registration deadline for "school teams" and "individual players" and is Monday, 12th February 2024. This deadline must be kept as we need to know at HVS how many teams to register in the league.*
