We meet at that the Wellington Harrier Club rooms on Alexander Road Mount Victoria. The season will start with a relay (Donaldson Memorial) near our club rooms on Mt Victoria. This relay race is a fun introduction with mixed teams of adults and kids, laps are about 1.5k, and new members are very welcome to come along and give it a go! We offer two midweek after school cross country trainings, run by Athletics New Zealand Accredited Coaches. Close to our clubrooms we are lucky to have 8 different training locations, providing lots of variety to keep trainings interesting and fun! Our clubrooms couldn't be in a better spot.

We also assist with training for primary/intermediate age children competing in the school's cross country competition and help with fitness for other sports. Our races are held on Saturday afternoons except for Wellington Cross Country Champs. They are held on a Sunday. There are 5 club races and 7 interclub races. throughout the season and entry to these races is free. (Note interclub races are only open to club members). The membership period lasts for 12 months so if you join in the winter it also covers the summer athletics program which is held at Newtown Park.
