Kia Ora Whānau,

Last year, Principals were given funding to use for their professional development and wellbeing in our Collective Agreement, so I am off to Banff in Canada to a Leadership Conference. I will be leaving on Wednesday 10 April and returning during the holidays.

There is a delegation of Principals from Wellington and all over New Zealand going. We are also going to visit the Calgary Department of Education to meet with the Director at the Indigenous Centre and some kura. I look forward to sharing what I learn while I am away.

As I will miss the last couple of days of this term, I wanted to wish everyone a safe April holiday.

Active Transport Team

During Movin' March we had a group of ākonga working on an active transport project. They have been researching where all of our whanau live, which routes they use to get to and from school, and where our tamariki feel unsafe when travelling to and from school. The board has also been looking into this and carried out a survey with our whanau too. We used all of this information when we met with Councillor Tim Brown and Councillor Sarah Free on Tuesday afternoon to discuss ways to make it safer to use active transport when coming to and from school and ways to make it safer around our kural.

Our akonga did a fantastic presentation of their findings. Both councillors were impressed with this, as were all of our staff and whanau who attended. We update you as this progresses.





Property Update

It is looking very unlikely that we will be able to move back into the Junior block during the holidays due to all of the additional work we have had to do. The project has become much bigger than planned or initially designed. Our team on site is working as hard as they can to get us in as soon as possible. It also means we have had to try and secure additional funding from the Ministry of Education. We haven't yet got a finalised date yet. I understand that it has been difficult for some of our tamariki in the Hall so if you have any questions please come and see me or drop me an email - <u>principal@houghton.school.nz</u>

We are also going to be getting our sewage drains replaced during the April holidays so that they can connect to all the new drains that have been installed during the refurbishment of the junior block; this means most of the concrete areas of the school will be out of use so please avoid these spaces. The field, bike track and playground will be open for you to use.

BOT UPDATE

Kia ora koutou e Te Kura o Haewai whānau,

Year 2024 keeps rocking on and as we head towards the end of our Term 1 we have a few important updates to share.

We have formally updated our Cell Phone and Curriculum and Student Achievement Policies to adhere to the new government's directive in these areas – namely to ban cell phones in the classroom and to ensure we are teaching an average of one hour a day of maths, reading and writing, or pānui, tuhituhi, and pāngarau. Our kura was largely adhering to these policies already, so the updates are very minor policies (and whānau can view these all school policies) website https://houghton.school.nz/policies-and-procedures

We also wanted to update you on the playground which has been partially closed off for health and safety reasons. We have now received a report outlining the work needed to get the playground up to standard so it can be re-opened. The good news is that the work is not as significant as we had first thought. Who can attend: Children aged 5-13 yrs

What do you need to bring: Shoes and appropriate clothing, jacket or sweatshirt, hat, drink bottle and food.

Food: Please bring plenty of packed food and drink for morning tea/lunch/afternoon tea. Lunch will be from approximately 12:30pm to 1:00pm each day.

Programme activities: Programme activities are adapted to suit children of all ages and children may be grouped by age depending on numbers. Programme activities may vary without notice dependent on weather conditions and programme numbers.

Payment details: Payment is required before the holiday programme begins. An invoice will be issued when a completed booking is received. All payment details will be included on the invoice.
